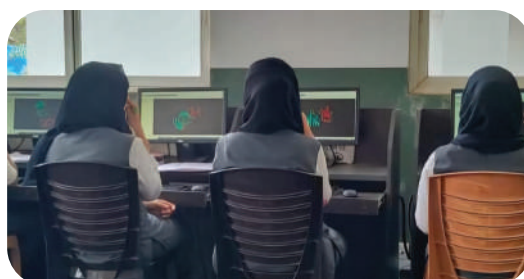
Continuing Pharmacy Education Programme 2023 (01.01.2023)

ORIENTATION CLASSES FOR NEW STUDENTS

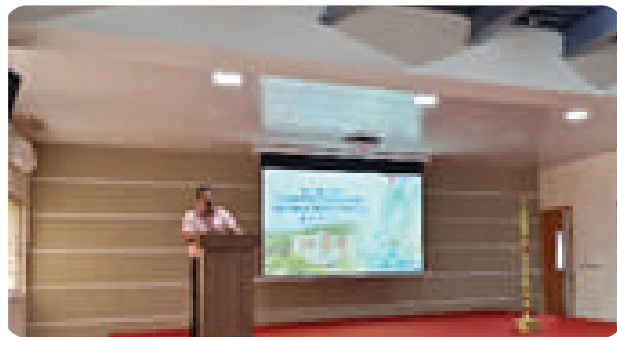
B Pharm Batch 2022 Orientation Class (02.01.2023)

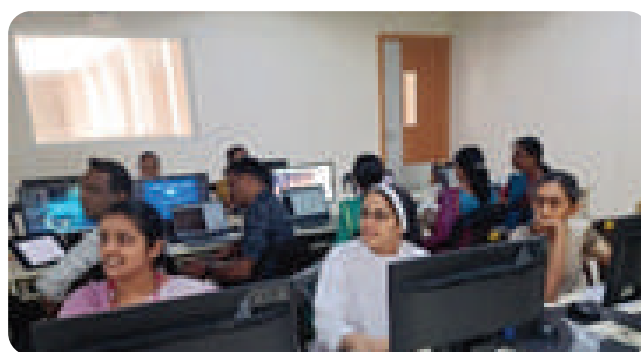
Faculty training programme on Smart use of Senses Smart Board for Smart Classes (23.06.2023)

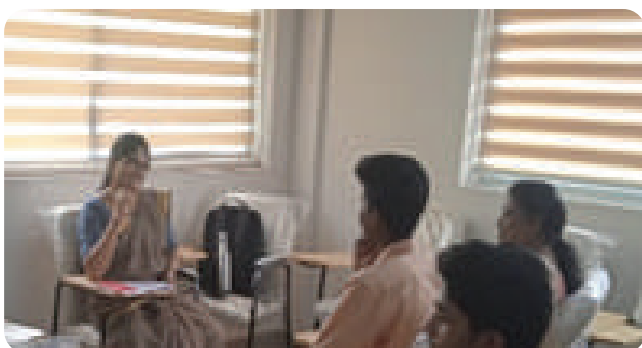
Parent – Faculty meeting for second semester B Pharm 2021 batch (21.01.2023)

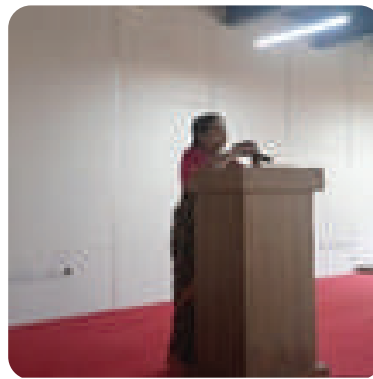
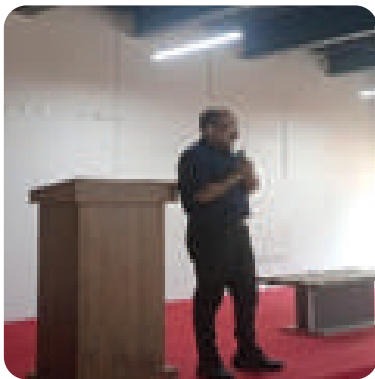
Parent faculty meeting– Third semester B Pharm (Troizeanz) (27.06.2023)

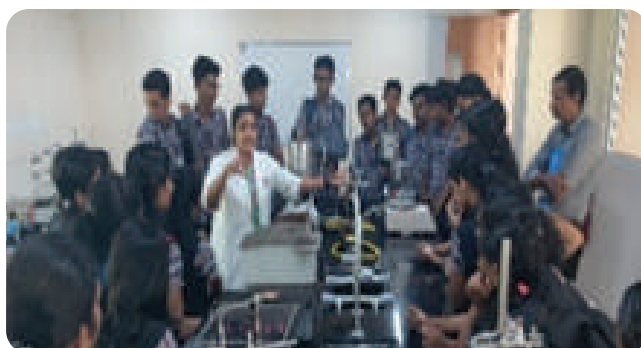

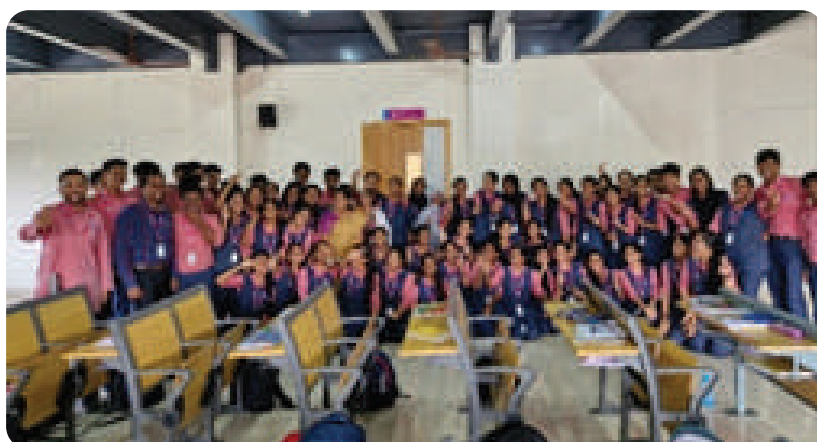
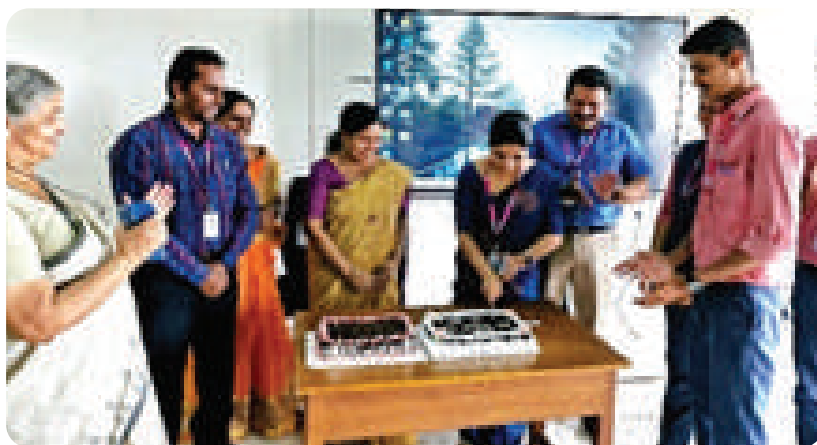
Bon voyage – Official sent-off party to D Pharm students (16.06.2023)

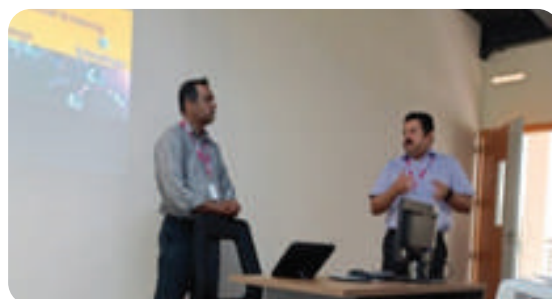
Faculty development programme on molecular docking (22.03.2023)

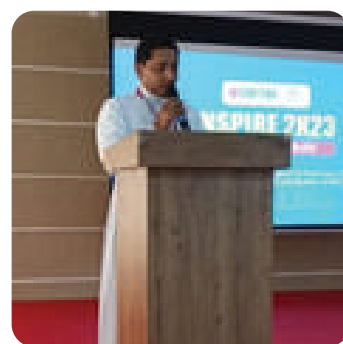

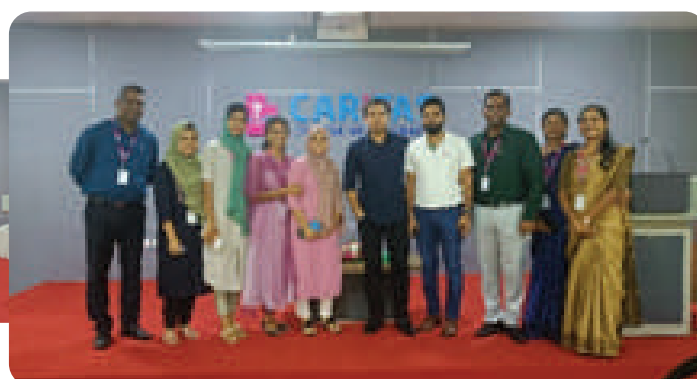
Inspire 2023 (24.06.2023)

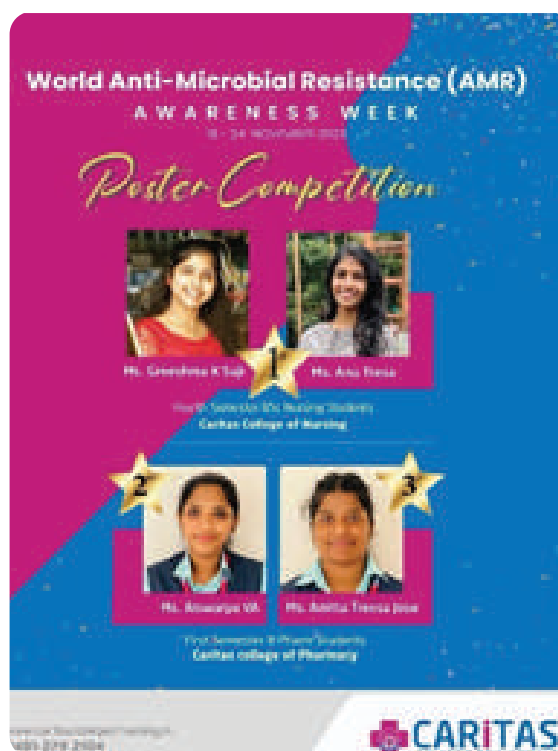

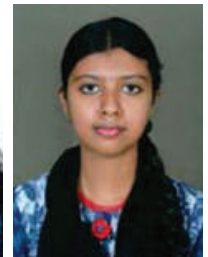

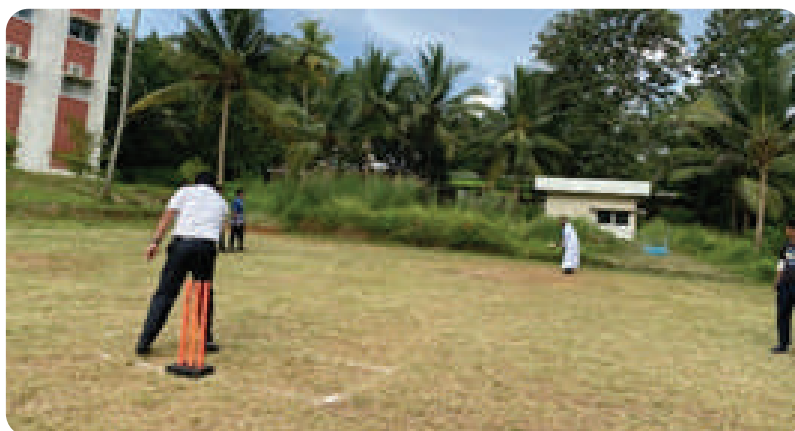
Official visit of delegates from University of Salford to Caritas college of pharmacy (30.10.2023)

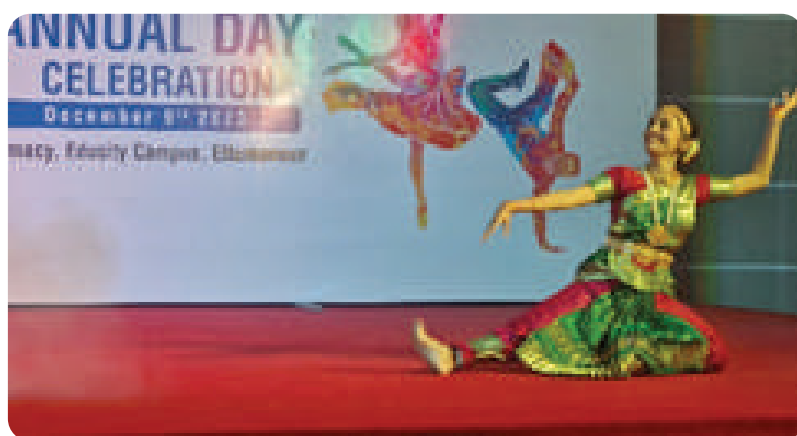
Caritas Sports league (CSL) 2023 (06.11.2023 to 15.11.2023)

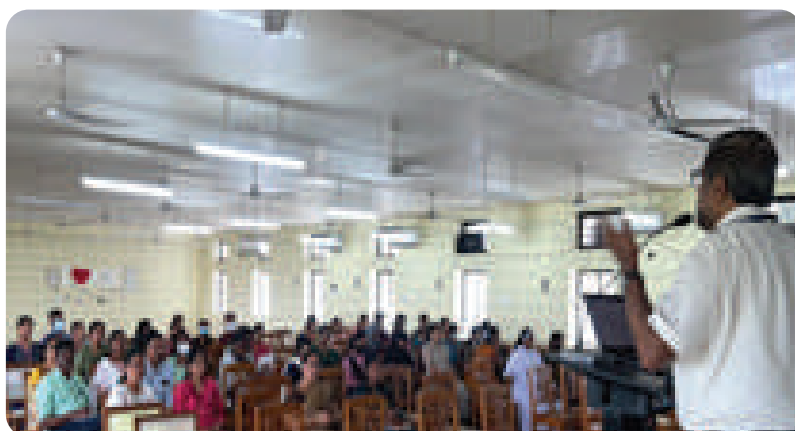
College Annual Day 2023 (09.12.2023)

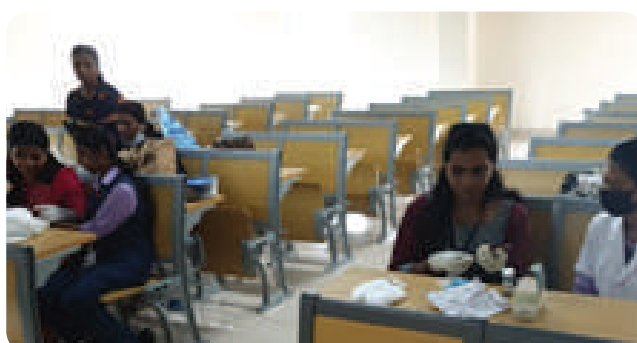
Faculty representatives attended Student Support and Guidance Programme (SSGP) district review meeting held at Government Medical College, Kottayam (17.05.2023)
