1. Introduction

Caritas College of Pharmacy was established in 23rd March 1981 under the eminent guidance and vision of His Excellency Mar Kuriakose Kunnassery, the then Bishop of Kottayam. It was the second to start pharmacy education in private sector in Kerala and also has the status of minority institution.

This prospectus sets out rules and regulations for selection and admission to B. Pharm course for the academic year 2025-26 in Caritas College of Pharmacy. Selection of candidates will be purely on a merit basis.

This prospectus is subject to modifications/ deletions as may be deemed to be necessary by the said institution and to further orders if any passed by courts of law.

4. Eligibility for Admission

(a) For Pharm D Course

1. Candidates must be citizens of India
2. (a) Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Biology/ Mathematics separately and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics put together are eligible.

OR

- (b) A pass in D.Pharm Course with a minimum of 50% marks in D.Pharm examination from an institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India under Section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

(3) Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

3. The applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31.05.2025.

5. How to Apply

Candidates shall apply online through the link available in the college website www.caritascollege.edu.in. Application fee of Rs 500 can be remitted online.

A hard copy of the application along with the copy of the qualifying examination mark list, copy of age proof should be submitted to the college before the last date.

6. Preparation of Rank List for admission to Management quota seat

The marks obtained by the candidates in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or authority of other states shall be equated with the marks obtained by the candidates in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the Director of HSE, Kerala. Marks obtained by the candidates under various streams of examinations such as HSE in Kerala/CBSE/ICSE etc. will be subject to the process of normalization.

Explanation: Under the method of normalization, the highest mark obtained by students of various Boards in each subject shall be equated to the highest mark obtained by the students of the Kerala Higher Secondary examination in that subject and the relative marks obtained by other students in that subject shall be determined accordingly.

Illustration: If the highest marks secured by the applicant of the Kerala state HSE, in Physics is 100 and the highest mark secured by a applicant on any other board in the same subject is 90, both the highest marks will be considered to be equal to 100, if an applicant of the other board secures 60 marks in Physics when the highest mark in Physics in the same board is 90, the 60 marks will be considered to be equal to 66.67marks as arrived at below:

$$100 \times 60 / 90 = 66.66\%$$

Rank list for admission to Pharm D Course under management quota seat is prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in Physics and Chemistry put together in the second year of the qualifying examination. The index mark is computed out of 100. In the case of a tie in the index mark computed for the preparation of B Pharm rank list the candidate with the higher mark in chemistry in the second year of the qualifying examination put together will be placed higher in the ranking. If there is still a tie, the age of the candidate will be considered, and the elder candidate will be placed higher in the ranking.

8. Procedure of Admission

Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the college after paying the Tuition fee, Caution Deposit and Special fee etc. as mentioned in the clause-11, failing which, the offer of admission will be cancelled.

9. Mode of payment:

Fees can be paid by online mode through the link given in our website. In the case of SC/ST candidates, their liability to pay fees shall be governed by the Orders issued from time to time issued by the Central and the State Governments and those of SC/ST Departments. No fees will be collected from SC/ST students or other eligible candidates except in accordance with the orders of the Central or the State Government.

10. Documents to be submitted at the time of Admission: -

The following documents in the original along with one set of self-attested copies shall be submitted at the time of admission.

1. Marks Card of qualifying examination (Higher secondary or Equivalent)
2. Eligibility/ Equivalence certificate if the candidate has passed the qualifying examination from other states
3. SSLC Certificate/10th Standard certificate
4. T.C from the institution last studied.
5. Character and Conduct certificate from the institution last studied
6. Physical fitness certificate from medical officer
7. Recent passport size photograph (Six copies)
8. Copy of AADHAR card.

12. Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Pharmacy College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent "Civil Court".

13. Code of Conduct

Every student is required to adhere strictly to the code of conduct of the institution.

14. Caution: Prohibition of Ragging

Ragging/ any type of misconduct towards any students either in the college campus or outside will be considered as a criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police. Perpetrators will not be permitted to continue their study. Every student shall at the time of admission furnish a character certificate from the institute where from he/ she has passed the qualifying examination/ the course last attended. Such a certificate should mention the status of his /her behavioral pattern especially in terms as to whether he/she had displayed persistent violent or aggressive behavior or any desire to harm others.
