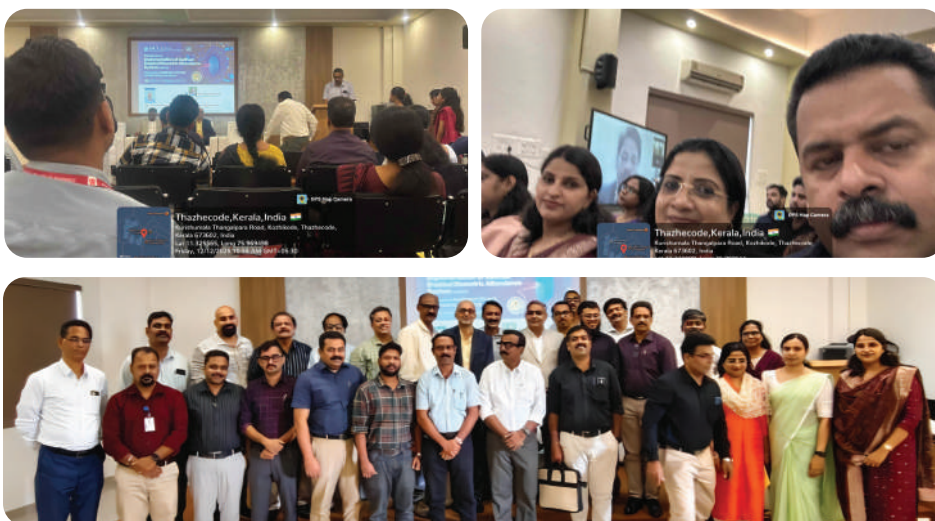

## Dr Linda Mathew as resource person for session during CAMRA – Conference on antimicrobial resistance awareness 2025 (30-11-2025)

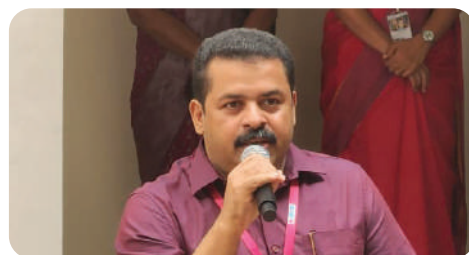

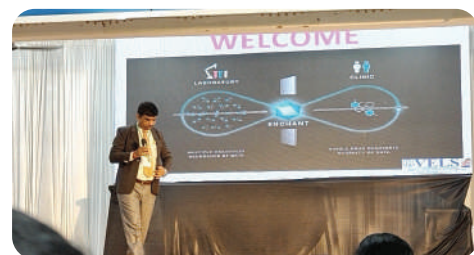

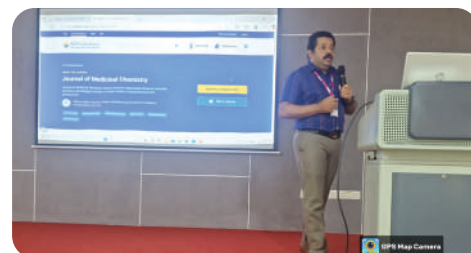
## Special training programme – Caritas AMS – Integration with OBE and aspects of CO – PO mapping (19.7.2025)

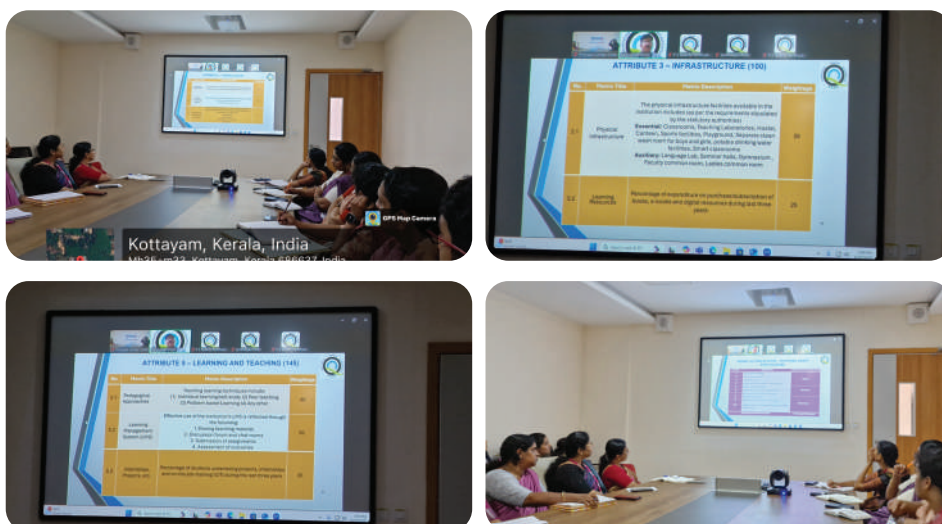
## Research skill impartment training – Reference management softwares (30.7.2025)

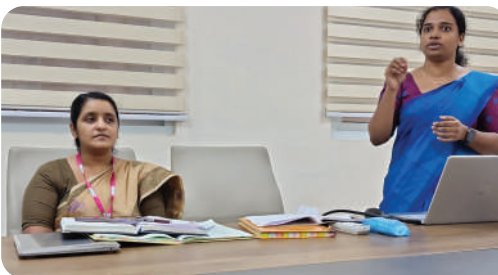
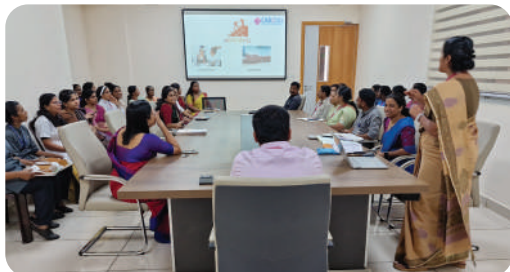
## Special online session on aspects of NAAC – By PSQC ISDE agency (29.08.2025)

## Inaugural event of state level pharmacy week celebrations – Kerala state pharmacy council (16.11.2025)

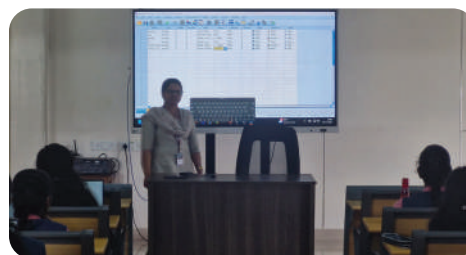

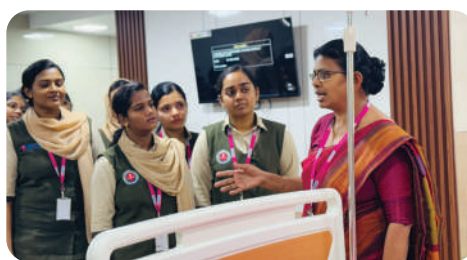
### Chaitanya Karshika Mela – Cultural and cinematic dance performances by students of Caritas college of pharmacy 2025 (7-2-2025)

## Level up – Workshop on A I for efficient administration and research (12.12.2025)

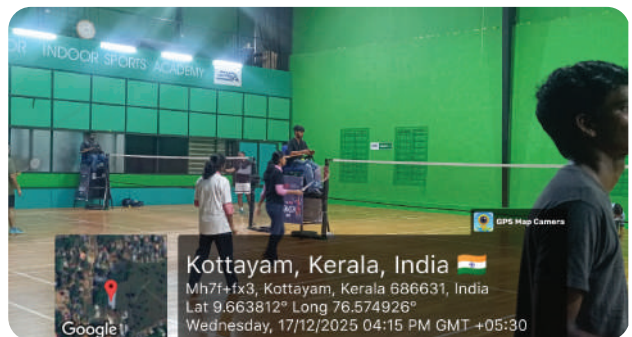
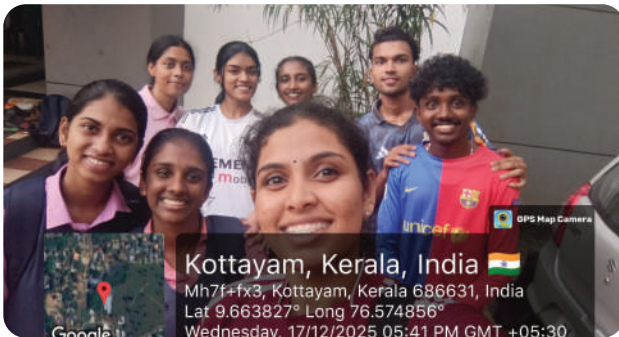

## Academic and infrastructural document verification by external quality assurance agency, PSQC ISDE (04.04.2025)

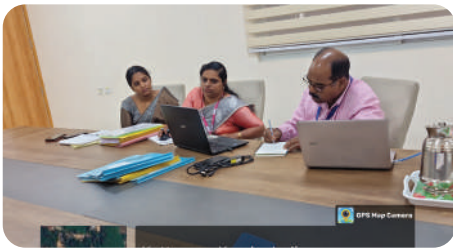

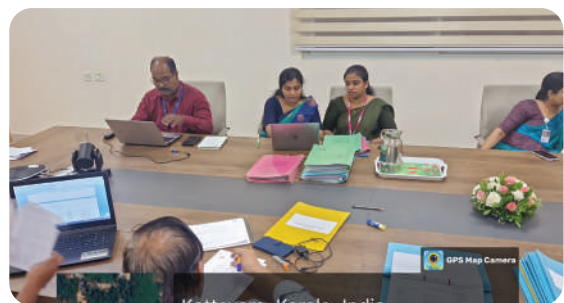
## Internal document verification and audit by PSQC experts, prior to ISO EOMS 21001 2018 surveillance audit II (9.6.2025)

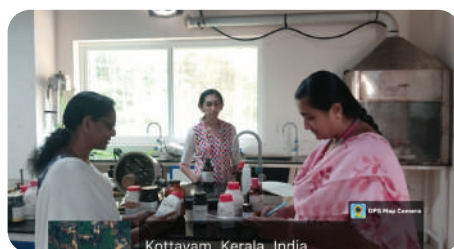
## Annual instrumentation audit and calibration by external agency (25.4.2025)

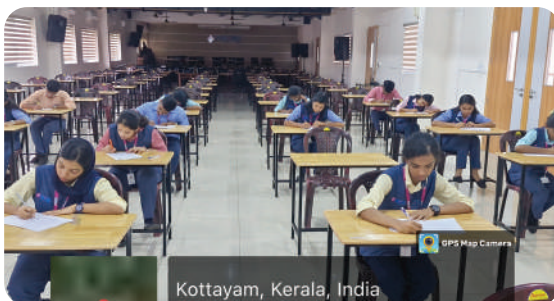

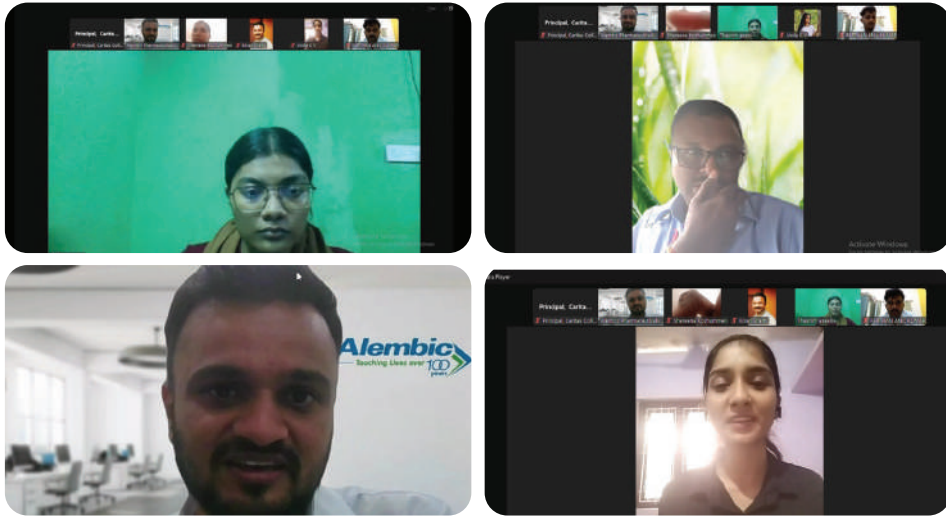
## Special bridge course – 3 day programme – Orientation programme for new D Pharm, B Pharm and Pharm D students (10.11.2025 to 12.11.2025)

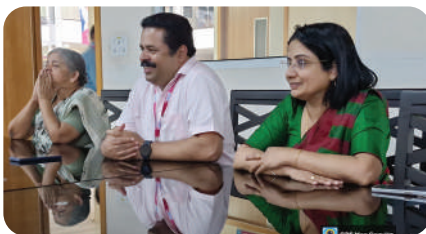
## Kickstart your life: For a world beyond addiction (26.6.2025)

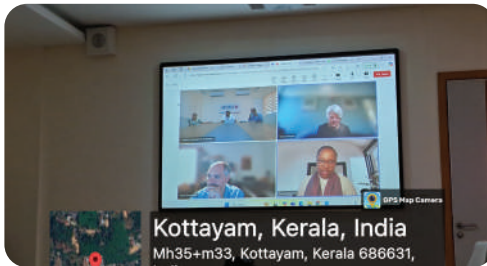
## Guest talk – World physiotherapy day – Role of physiotherapy in life style fitness and healthy ageing (12.9.2025)

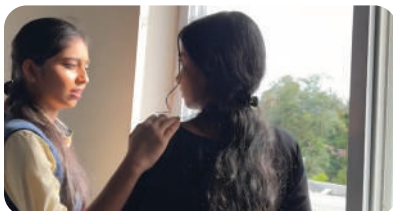

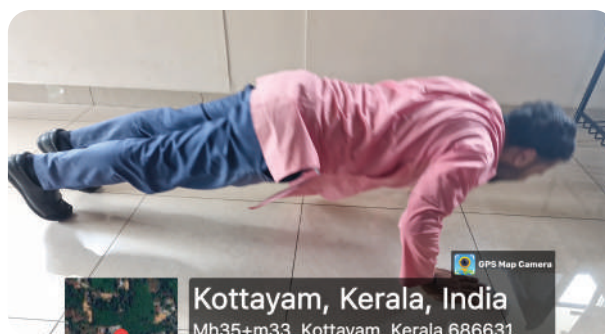
